

## Leadsonline Install & Setup

### Scrap Dragon

1. To set up a yard for Leadsonline uploading, the yard must obtain a store number, user name and password from Leadsonline.
2. First install version 1.1 sp 1 of the .net framework  
(<http://www.microsoft.com/downloads/en/details.aspx?familyid=a8f5654f-088e-40b2-bbdb-a83353618b38>)  
NOTE: The service does not work with the newer versions of the .NET framework.
3. On the server, open the secure export instruction page at  
[www.leadsonline.com/downloads/SecureExport.htm](http://www.leadsonline.com/downloads/SecureExport.htm)
4. Using the link on the instruction page, download the server installation package for .txt files and install. .
5. Create a sub-folder in the dragon folder called 'leadsonline' to be the export folder
6. In notepad, open the config file C:\Program Files\Leadsonline\SecureLeadsExportSetup\SecureLeadsExport.exe.config and carefully change the monitor path from c:\in to c:\dragon\leadsonline (or whatever you named the export folder in step 4) without making any other changes.
7. start the leadsonline service
8. In Scrap Dragon, add Leadsonline to the user menu
9. Run the export and select Transfer Options.
10. Enter the store number, export folder, user name, and password. specify Secure Export.

### Jpegger

1. in Jpegger Configure, choose the Leadsonline tab
2. select export images and enter the required info.
3. make sure that the file c:\windows\system32\wodsftp.ocx (attached) exists and is registered.
4. for each camera, designate as upload to leadsonline and specify the position and subject of the shot.
